ABOUT 'Human Rights To Care'

Ideas of Human Rights (HR) were enrolled in a long historical development, from the "Magna Carta", 1215 to the present. International and local organizations, treaties, codes, declarations, reports of compliance, trainings, round tables, debates, polls etc - all in all a created system for one purpose only: Respect for HR. Respect for fundamental HR is one of the fundamental principles of the EU and indispensable condition for its existence.

"Human Rights to Care" is a Training Course project designed to develop the capacity of 24 youth workers in the area of HR and HRE by building skills, transforming knowledge and shaping attitudes; equip them with necessary competences needed to develop and run youth mobility actions, particularly youth exchanges, coming to involve young people to address HR issues; developing the capacities to work with young people with fewer opportunities therefore promoting mainstreaming education.

- to increase participant's capacity to assess the needs of migrants, immigrants, refugee/asylum-seeker and national minorities and be culturally competent when working with affected youth within local events after the training
- to equip youth works with necessary knowledge, skills, and attitudes to organize a Human Rights learning process, based on the non-formal learning practice, principles, and quality standards of the EU youth programmes aiming to fight against racism and discrimination through education
- to introduce Erasmus+ Programme and familiarize participants with the key actions and programme priorities and objectives, therefore empowering collaboration with different organizations and develop further activities to be implemented within Erasmus+ Programme.

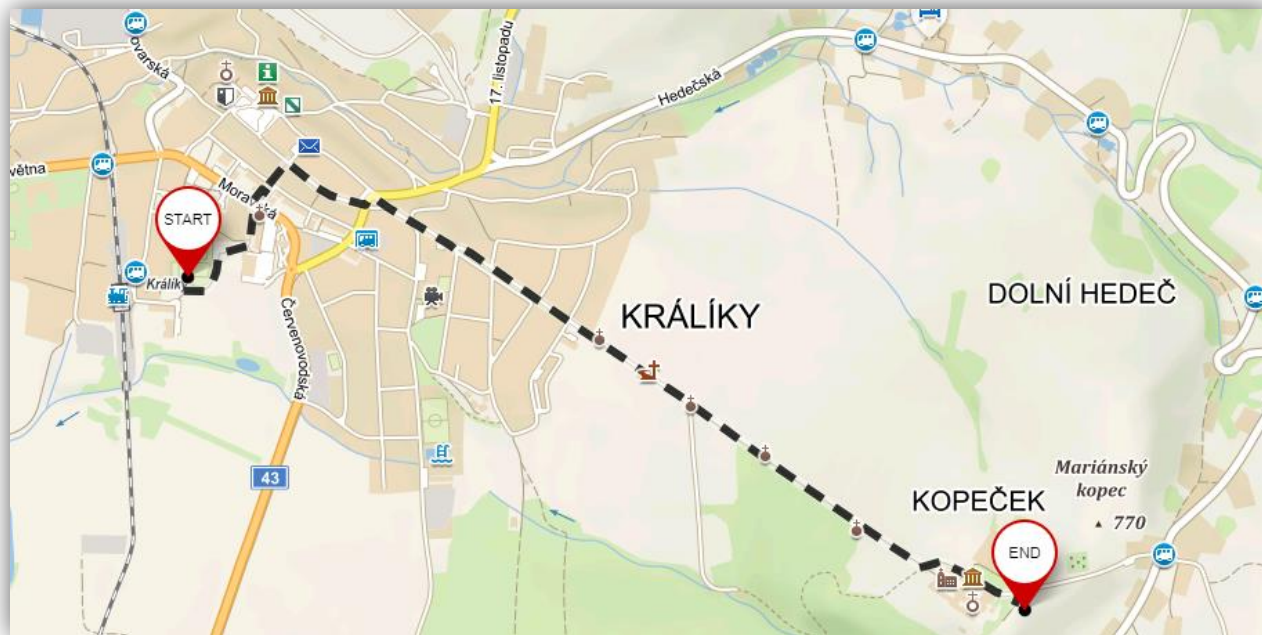
