PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Disinformation and false information, often referred to as fake news is not a new phenomenon, but it has gained interest in the last several years, due to the magnitude, the multimodality and the multiplicity of its manifestations and consequences in the digital post-truth era.


Fake news is created and disseminated with increasing speed, expertise and effectiveness in the digital context thus being more difficult to detect and resist. The fake news exploits the gullibility of media users, who frequently are not only biased, but also irrational and lazy. It is difficult to differentiate on digital and social media among true, misleading, or false content.

In general, mass media are the result of the people's need to satisfy such requirements as gaining news and information, entertainment, and socialization. However, the media are not the mirror of reality and their content is not always complete, accurate, and unbiased. One important way of addressing this problem is media literacy, which equips individuals with powerful tools and strategies of resilience and resistance to fake news. Media literacy creates and develops an adaptable and critical toolkit for detection of the fake news and protection from the harm they may cause.



So the project idea arises from the need of the young people. Since young people today get their information from social media, and therefore the risk of being "infected" with wrong information is greater, it is important that young workers respond to real challenges and be equipped with the skills and knowledge that young people need. It will be a road killer in the process of protecting "digital hygiene".

The main goal of the project is to strengthen the resilience of young people by teaching them the tools and programs needed to verify facts, recognize visual manipulations, and find primary sources.

How to reach Prudnnik:

There is no airport in Prudnik, although the closest big city with an airport is beautiful Wrocław.

Therefore, you can arrive in **Wroclaw**. The transportation is possible from Wrocław to Prudnik by regular bus.

Prudnik is also located close to the city of Opole.

The program includes a one-day tour in Opole.







Participants will be reimbursed of their travel costs according to the rules of the "Erasmus+" programme. In order to reimburse your travel costs, we'll need your ticket, invoice and boarding pass.

The refunding of costs will be done in EUR (official rate of currency recognized by "Erasmus+ programme) through bank transfer after the getting of all travel documents (invoice, ticket, boarding pass) included the travel of the participants to their home countries.
